All vessels entering the port will be categorised and any vessel entering the port which falls out with the advertised categories shall be categorised by the port

## 1 Schedule of Pilotage

**Pilotage Charge** £0.31

Per gross registered tonnage per entry and departure as per port pilotage directions

**Pilotage Exemption Charges (PEC)** £418.00

To qualify for a PEC the candidate must have completed 6 entries and 6 departures on the vessel within the past 12 months under supervision of a pilot.

**Annual renewal (PEC)** £137.50

For the annual renewal of a PEC the holder must have completed 3 arrivals and 3 departures within the previous 12 months

## 2 Commercial Vessels

**Gross Registered Tonne Charge** £0.65

All commercial vessels are subject to a charge per gross registered tonne on entry for each period of 1 week or part thereof, during which time the vessel is in the harbour. All tonnages are as per Lloyds register of shipping.

For vessels sailing from the harbour and put back by stress of weather or other cause, without having accomplished the voyage, no additional rates shall be charged on such return until such time as the period already paid for has expired.

**Personnel Transfer Vessels**

All personal transfer vessels using the Port will be charged per entry £70.26

**Bay Service Charge**

Using the ports Pilot vessel to retrieve or deliver to vessels within the Bay

Charge for the first hour or part thereof £329.67

Thereafter for every hour or part thereof £217.27

Monday to Friday within normal working hours, out with normal hours will incur an overtime charge.

**Linesman**

As required Monday to Friday normal working hours £58.34

As required out with normal working hours £110.85

**Passengers**

For each passenger who is not part of the established members of crew £2.17

When the attendance of harbour employees is required out with normal working hours, applicable overtime rates will apply

#### 5 Fishing & Guard Vessels

Any Fishing vessel entering the harbour will be charged on **Table 2**. For regular landing vessels the harbour operates a Composition Charge: -

Composition is 10 chargeable landings per annum (1 November to 31 October) whereby vessels will be charged on **Table 1**. Once composition is reached (ie have reached the amount dependent on the size of their vessel for 10 weeks harbour dues) there will be no further berthing charges on each landing. Vessels which have berthed in the harbour and have not reached the composition level when landing their whole catch will be charged the first week at **Table 1** until composition level is reached and **Table 2** at all other times.

The undernoted charges Table 2 are applicable to full time fishing vessels solely engaged in the act of fishing and full time fishing vessels who periodically engage in Guard Duty. For clarity, dedicated Guard Vessels who choose to retain their fishing number will not be classed as a full time fishing vessel.
